



Education Abroad in PSYCHOLOGY

Benefits of International Experience

For students in psychology, an international experience can be an integral component to the discipline and their studies at UVA. Education Abroad can further provide students with the skills and intercultural competence that is becoming invaluable in our increasingly multicultural and interconnected world. Upon return from studying abroad, many students report that they are equipped with greater language proficiency, deeper knowledge and understanding of various cultures, as well as a broader, more global perspective that is often valued by employers.

There is a wide range of opportunities available for coursework abroad in psychology. Students can integrate a semester, year, summer, or January-term program into their academic plan, earning both major credit and general elective credit toward their UVA degree.

Academic and Timing Considerations

Depending on the program you enroll in, you may receive either direct or transfer credit for the courses that you complete abroad. Please note that some programs have a language prerequisite. All students who wish to study abroad must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher, depending on the program you choose.

A maximum of 12 credits can be transferred towards the psychology major. Courses at the 2000-level are most suitable for transfer. Elective credit toward the major may be given for substantial courses, even if a comparable course is not offered in this department. Transfer credit for PSYC 3005, 3006, or 4000- and 5000-level courses is rarely given. Please note that PSYC 3005 must be completed before the fourth year (it is recommended that PSYC 3005/3006 are taken early on in the major). Students who wish to seek major credit through coursework at another institution must submit the Request for Transfer of Credit Form to the Director of Undergraduate Studies before going abroad.

To ensure a well-integrated study abroad experience, the Psychology department and the International Studies Office recommend planning early in your academic career. Speaking with an education abroad advisor and your Psychology academic advisor will help you find the best program with the best coursework to meet your personal and academic goals.

Steps to go abroad

- Get a passport
- Complete the online Education Abroad Workshop
- Meet with an ISO education abroad advisor and explore opportunities
- Talk with your department about timing and course requirements
- Learn about funding resources (financial aid, scholarships)
- Research programs and apply online
- Participate in cross-cultural seminars (CORE)
